Methodology

A web-based survey instrument was developed to enable the reporting of American citizens enrolled in AAVMC member institutions outside of the United States. Institutions were asked to provide graduation data for 2012 and anticipated enrollment for the classes of 2013, 2014, 2015. Institutions were also asked to anticipate the number of American students to enroll during this next academic year (beginning in 2013).

A total of 20 institutions were invited to participate in the survey between December 2012 and February 2013. Institutions invited to participate in the survey were:

As of March 1, 2013, 19 of 20 institutions have responded. A regional average of enrollees was included for the remaining institution; the resulting average resulted in the addition of 8 or fewer students per reported year.

Considerations

Institutions outside of the US may be 4 or 5 year academic programs. As a result, this survey sought to collect projected graduation data for the specific years listed.

Projected enrollment for classes seated in 2013 may evolve throughout the year because many institutions are in the midst of the admissions review process. These figures may represent offers made, offers already accepted and college or university admissions goals for American students.
