- This report includes, but is not limited to, a collection of data compiled through an internal members-only survey conducted each fall. The 30 colleges and schools of veterinary medicine in the United States, 5 Canadian colleges, and 14 international institutions were surveyed. A final report is distributed exclusively to participating members of the AAVMC in December. The Annual Data Report features data on faculty, staff, residents, interns and students from the all participating members of the AAVMC.

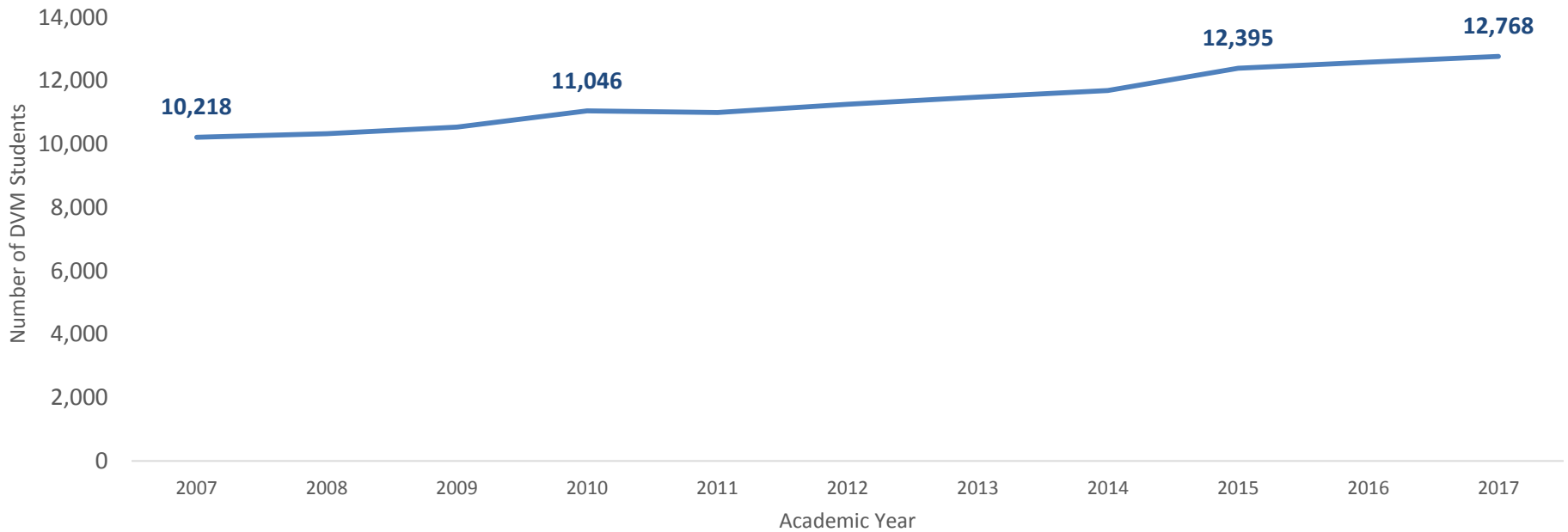

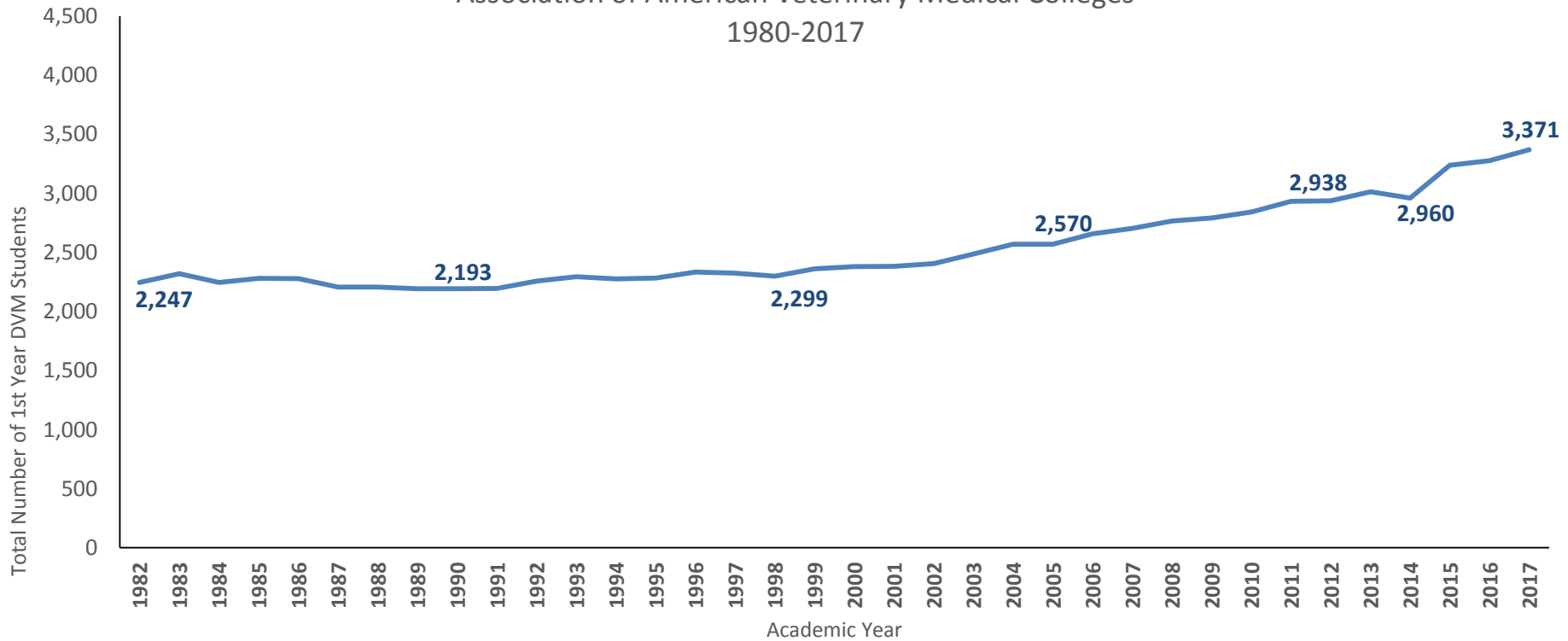

First Year DVM Student Enrollment at the US Colleges of Veterinary Medicine Association of American Veterinary Medical Colleges 1980-2017



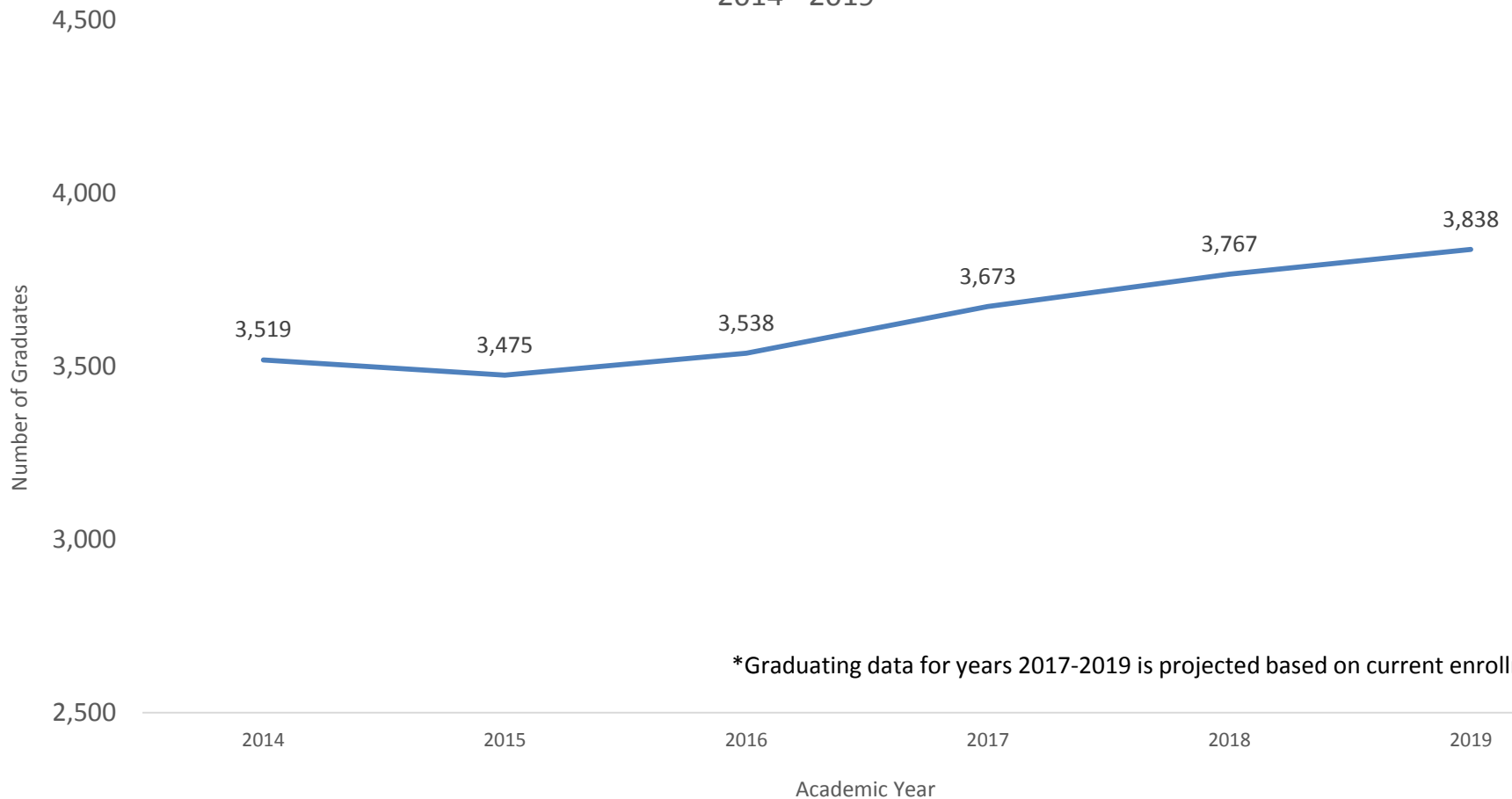

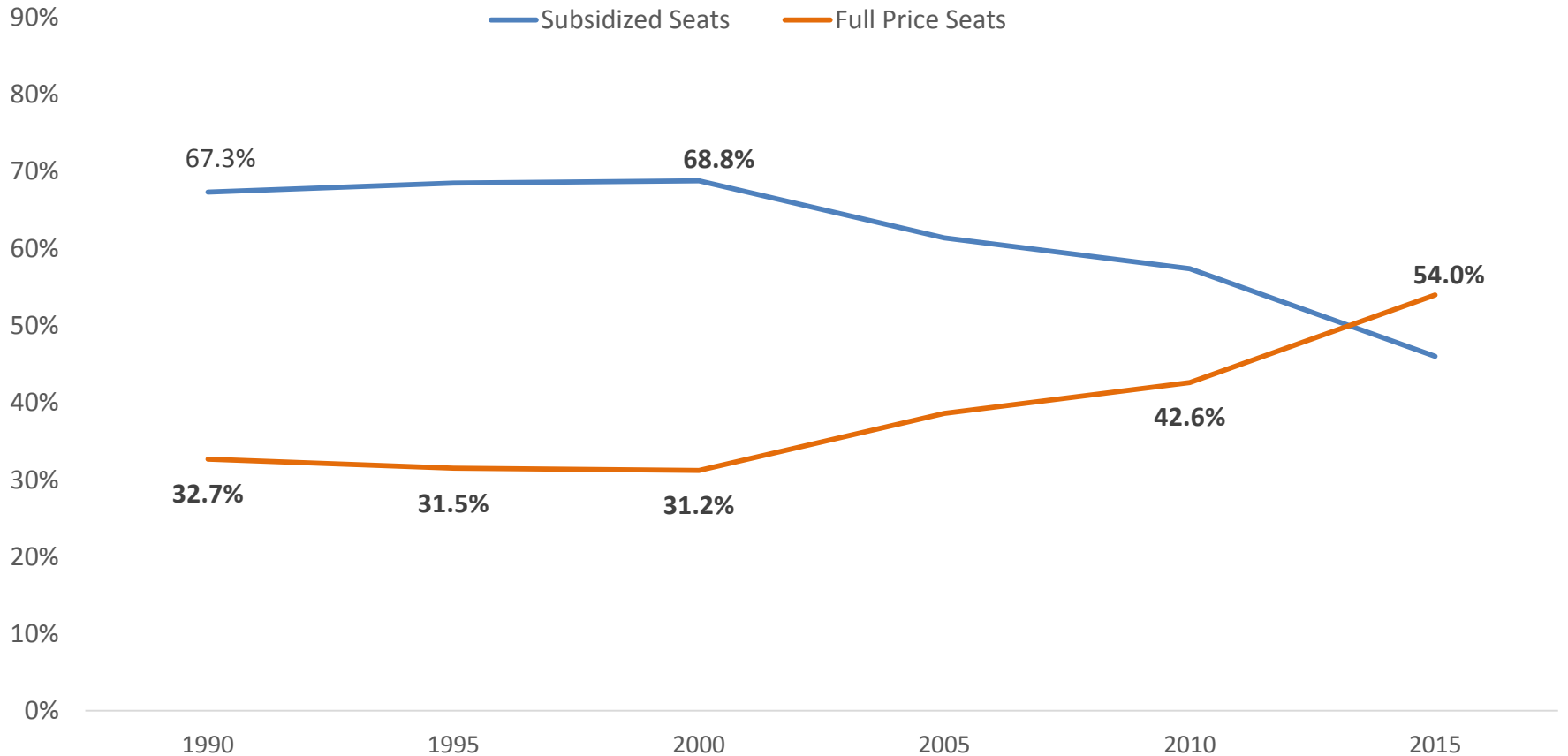

Full price seats are seats filled by non-resident students or students of private institutions.

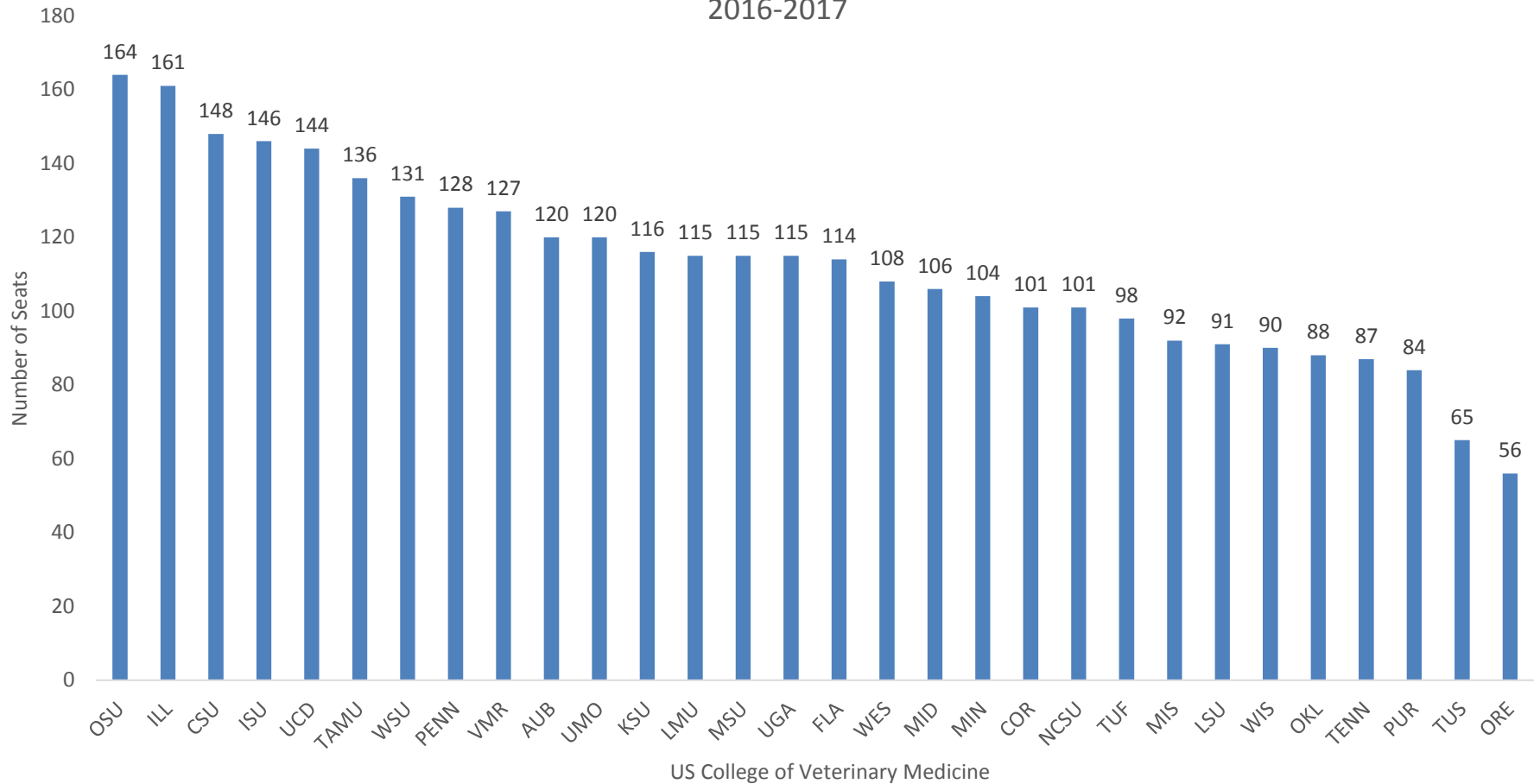


Number of Seats in the First Year Class

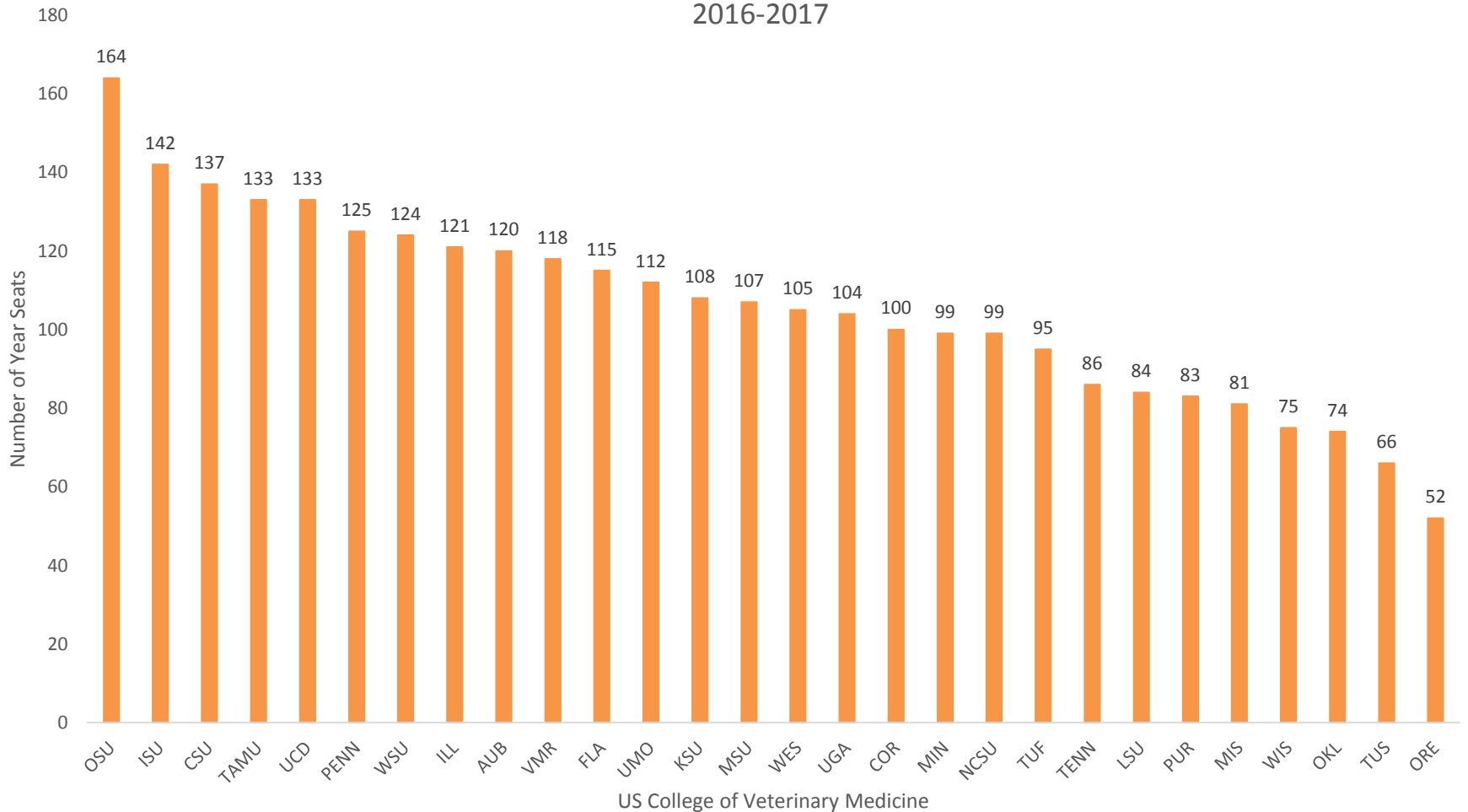


Number of Seats in the Class of 2017

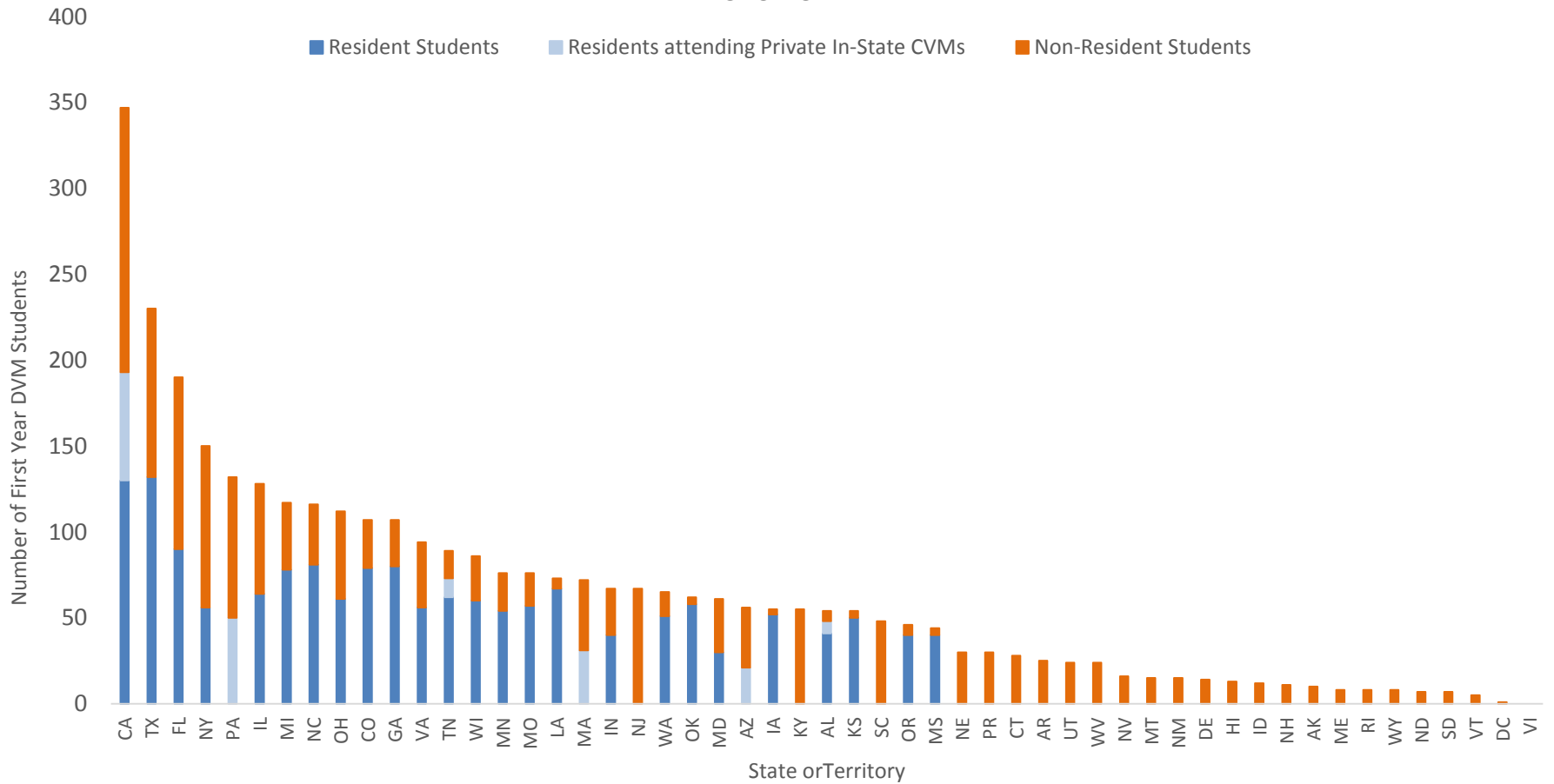

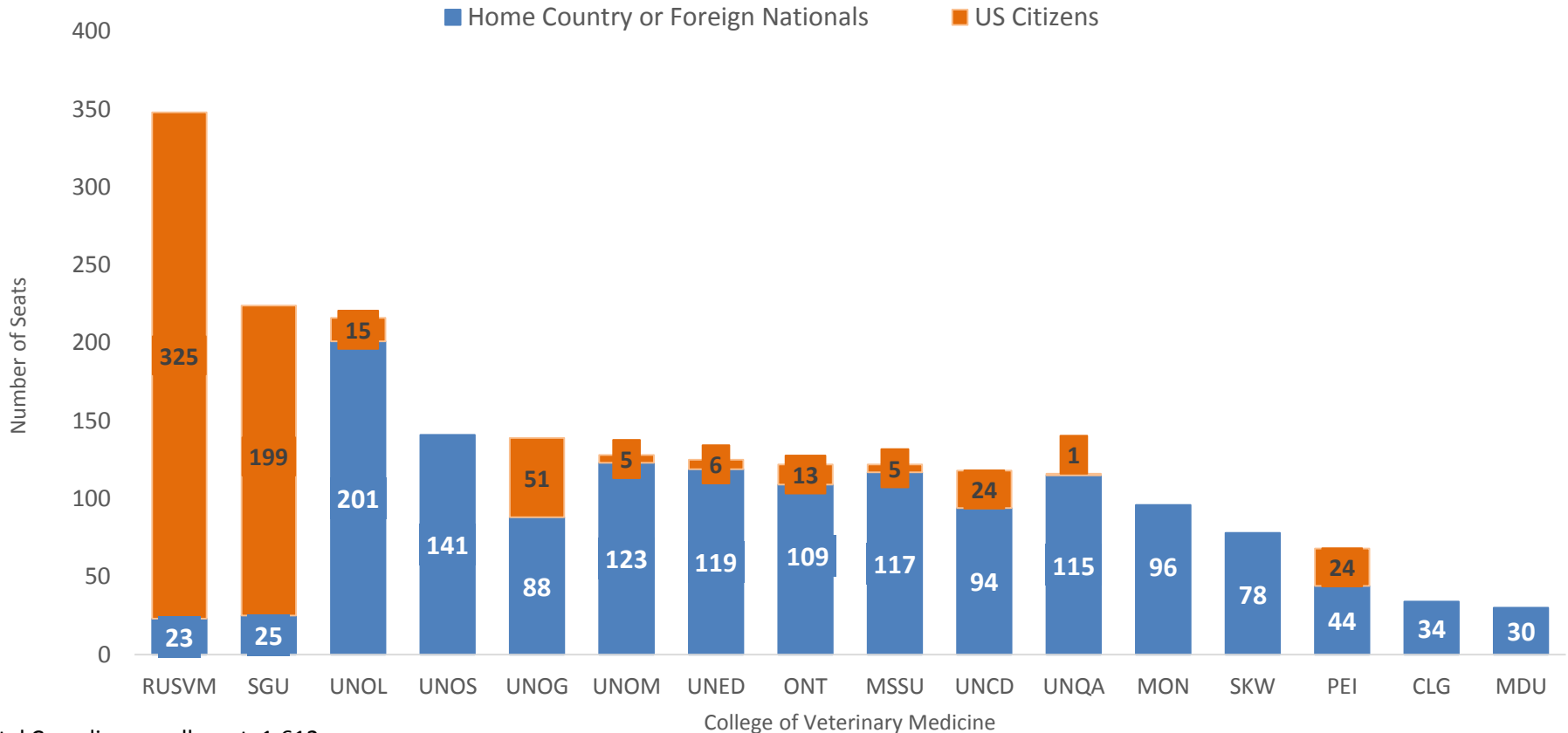

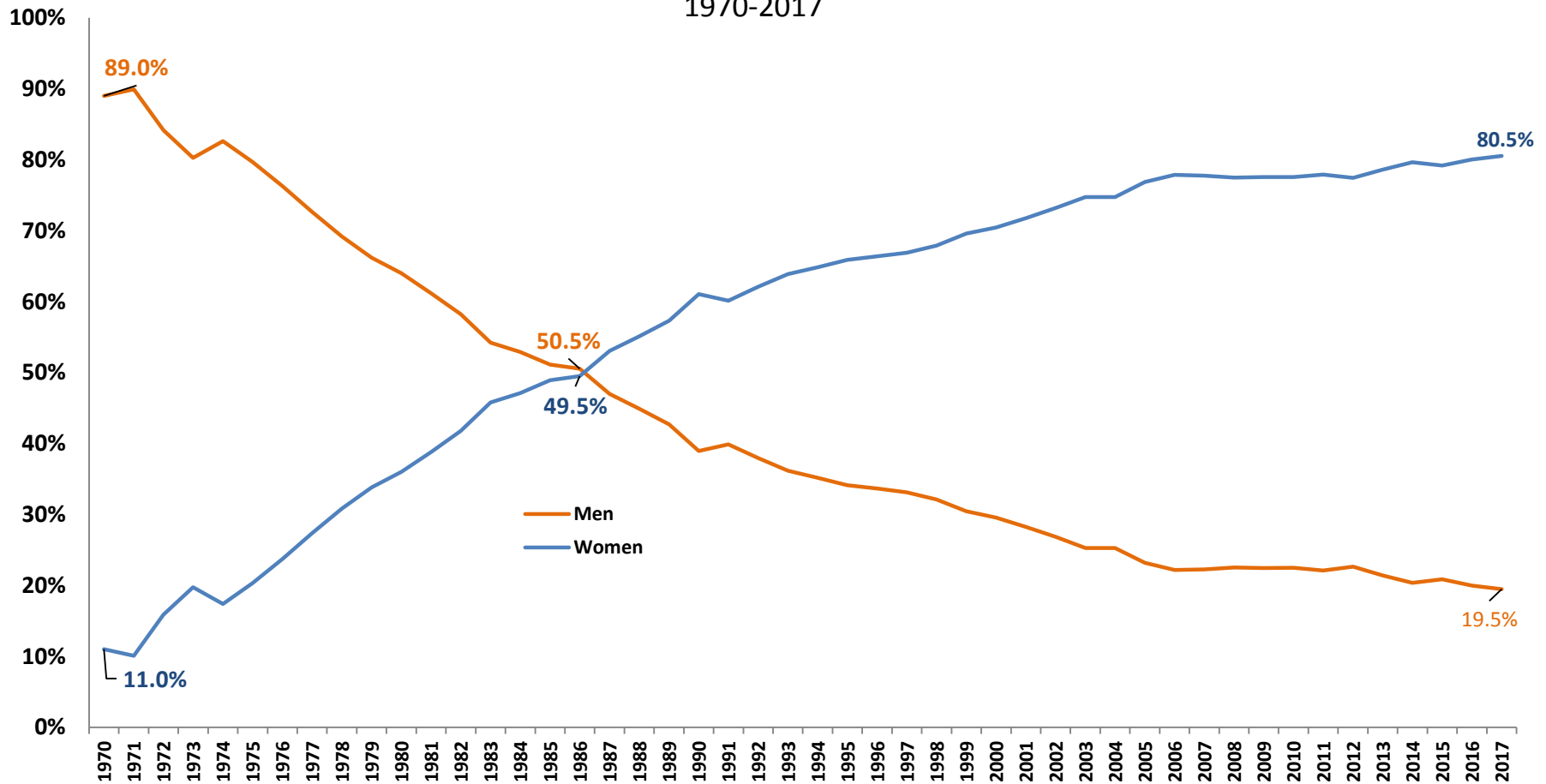

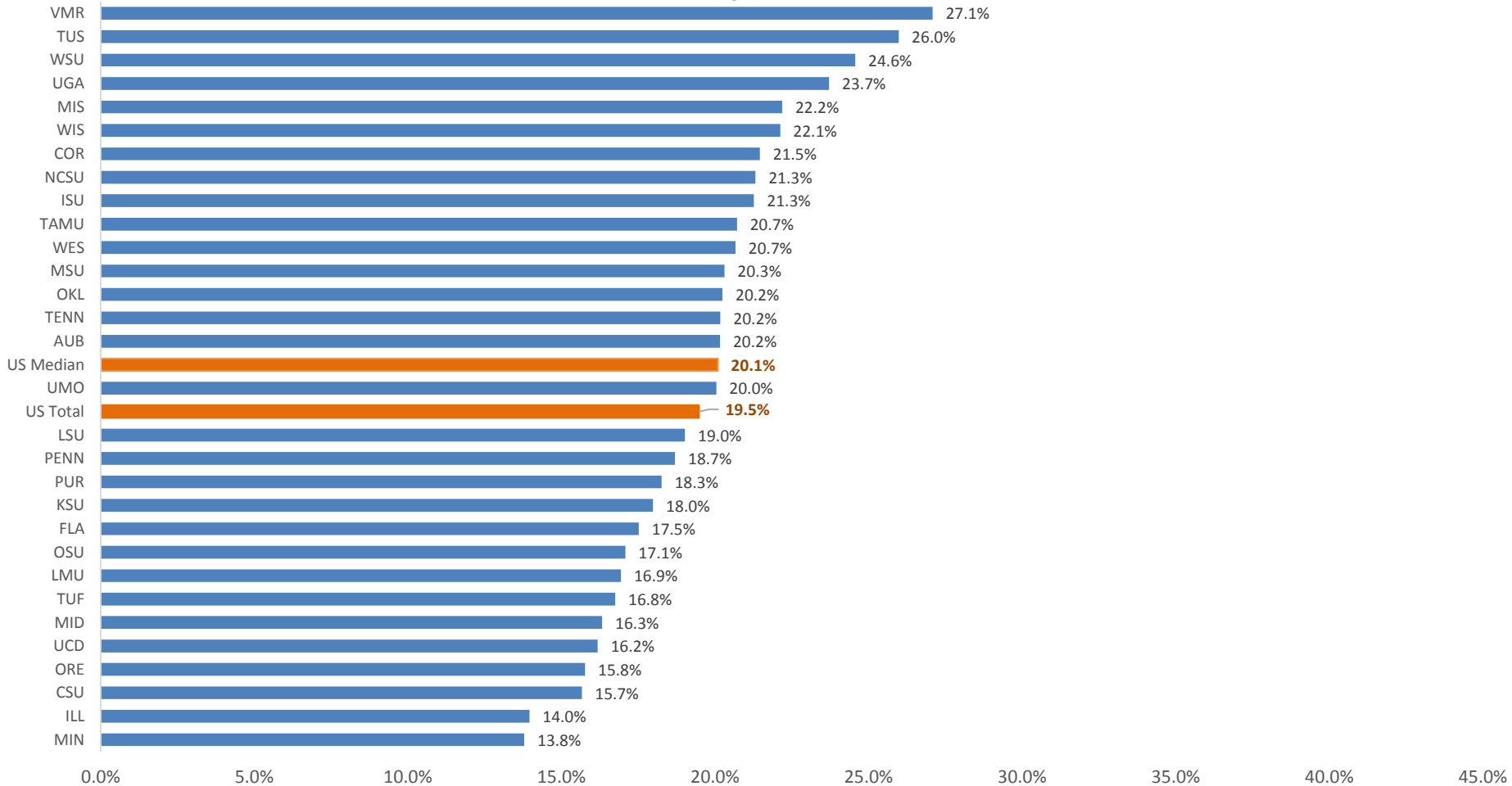


Presence of Male Students at US Colleges of Veterinary Medicine

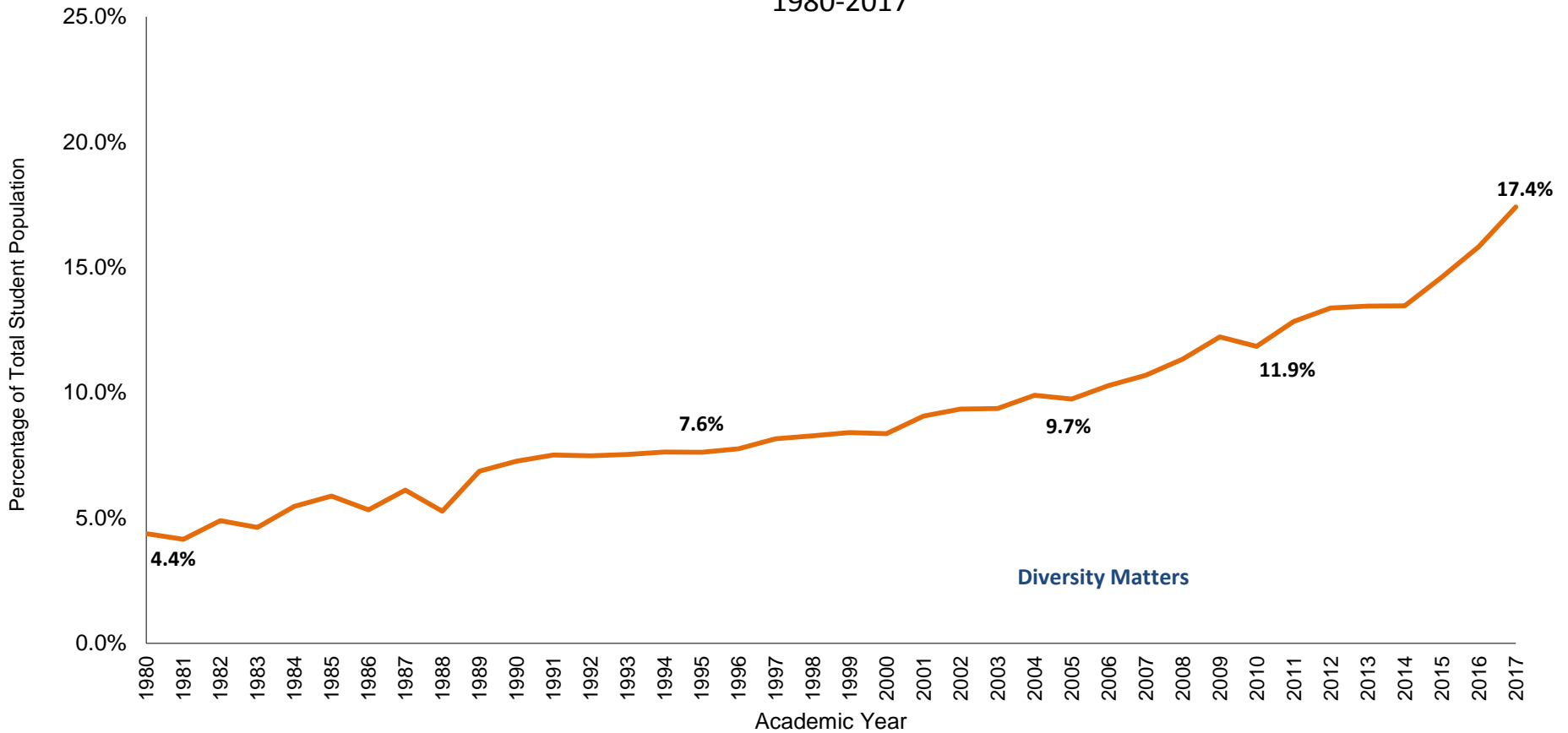

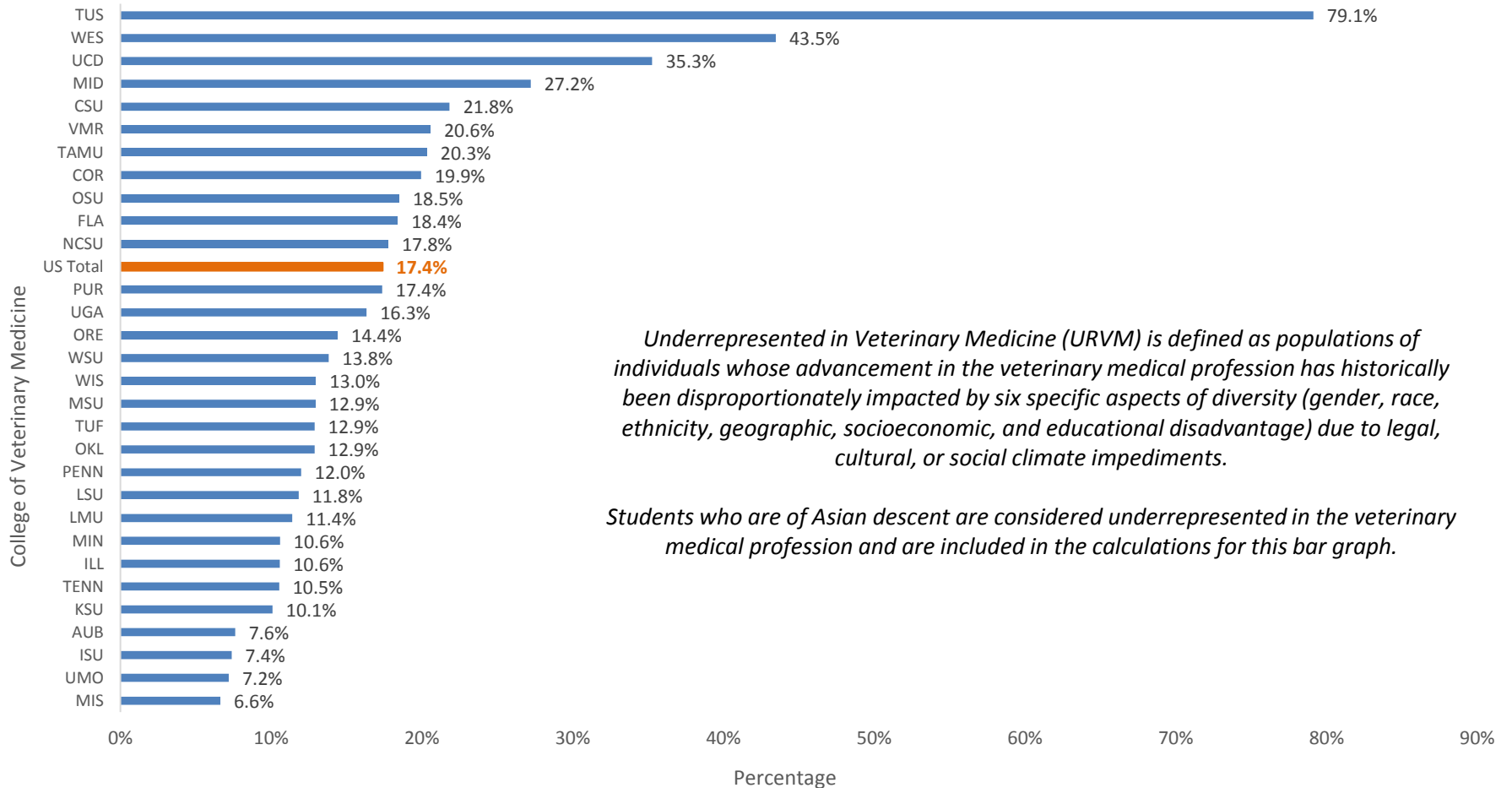

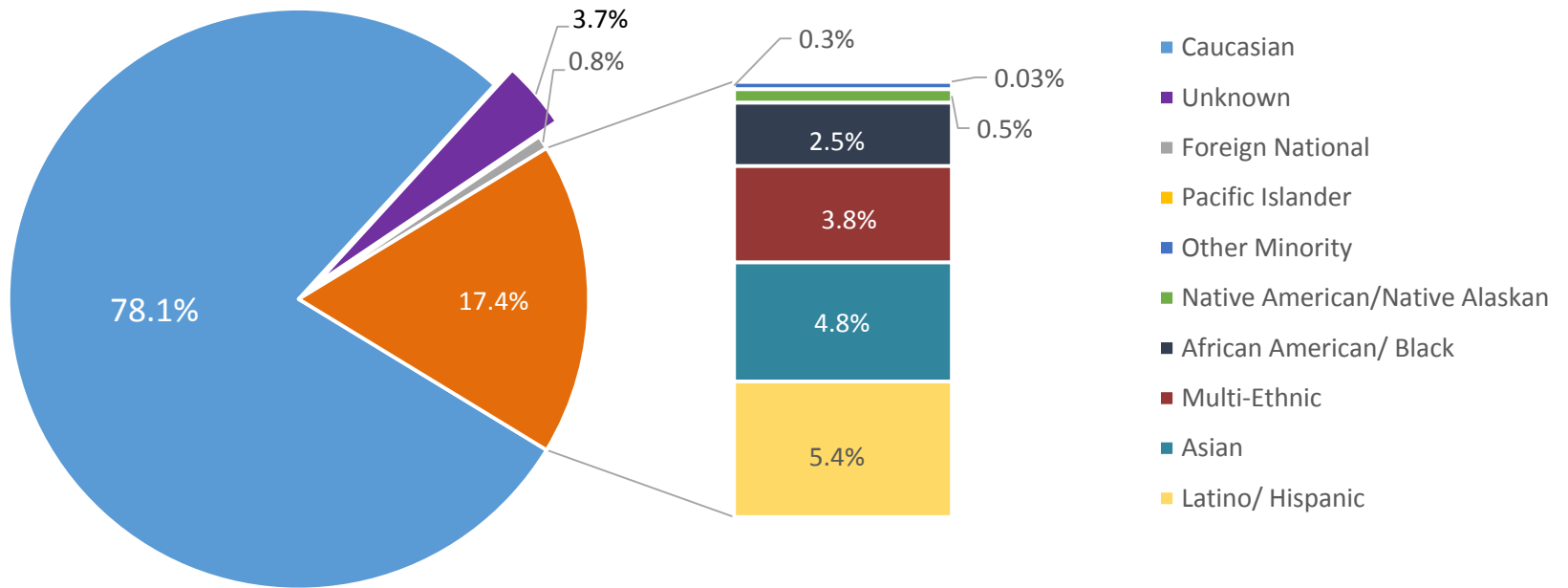


Underrepresented in Veterinary Medicine (URVM) is defined as populations of individuals whose advancement in the veterinary medical profession has historically been disproportionately impacted by six specific aspects of diversity (gender, race, ethnicity, geographic, socioeconomic, and educational disadvantage) due to legal, cultural, or social climate impediments.

Students who are of Asian descent are considered underrepresented in the veterinary medical profession and are included in the calculations for this bar graph.

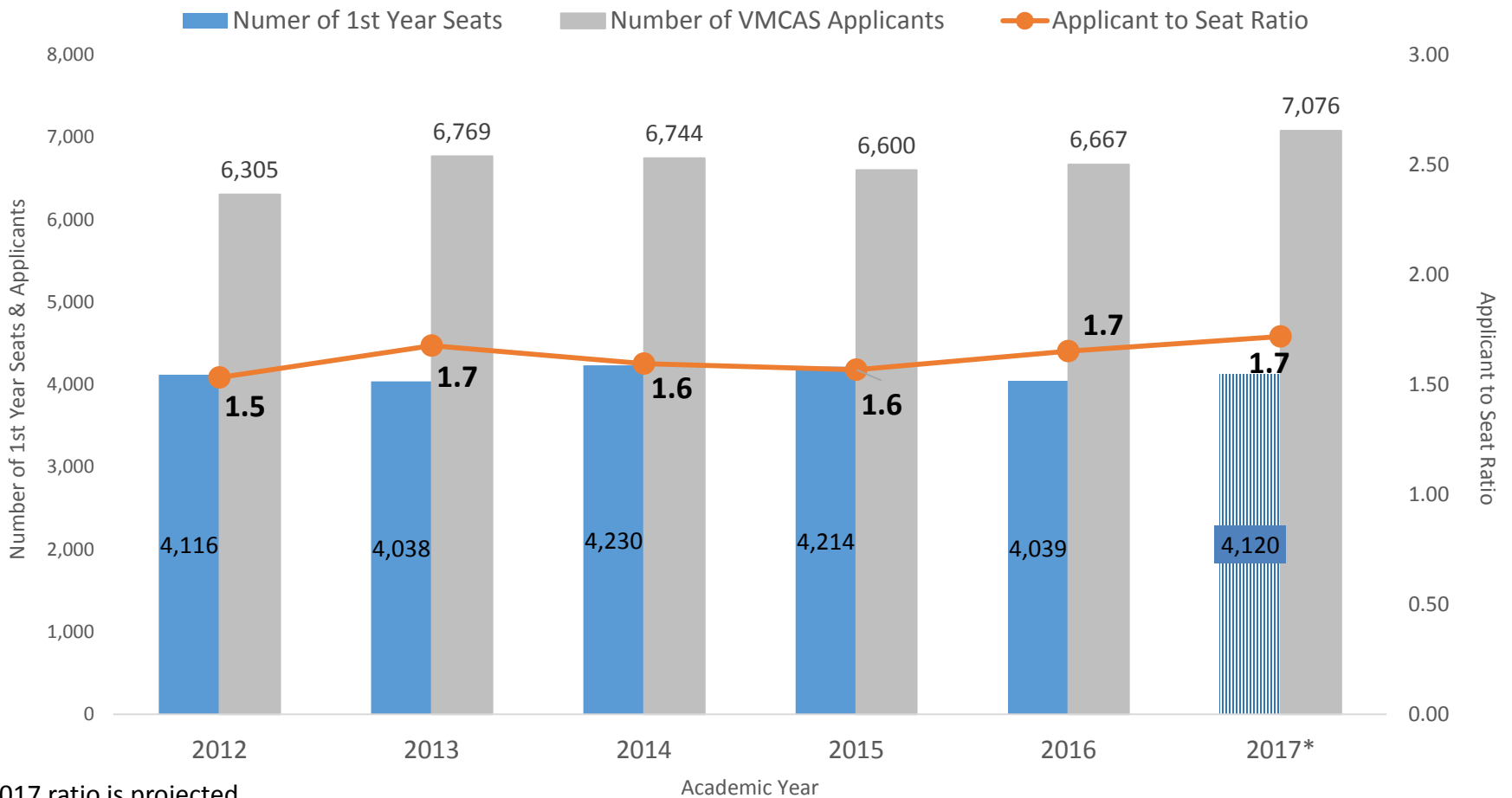

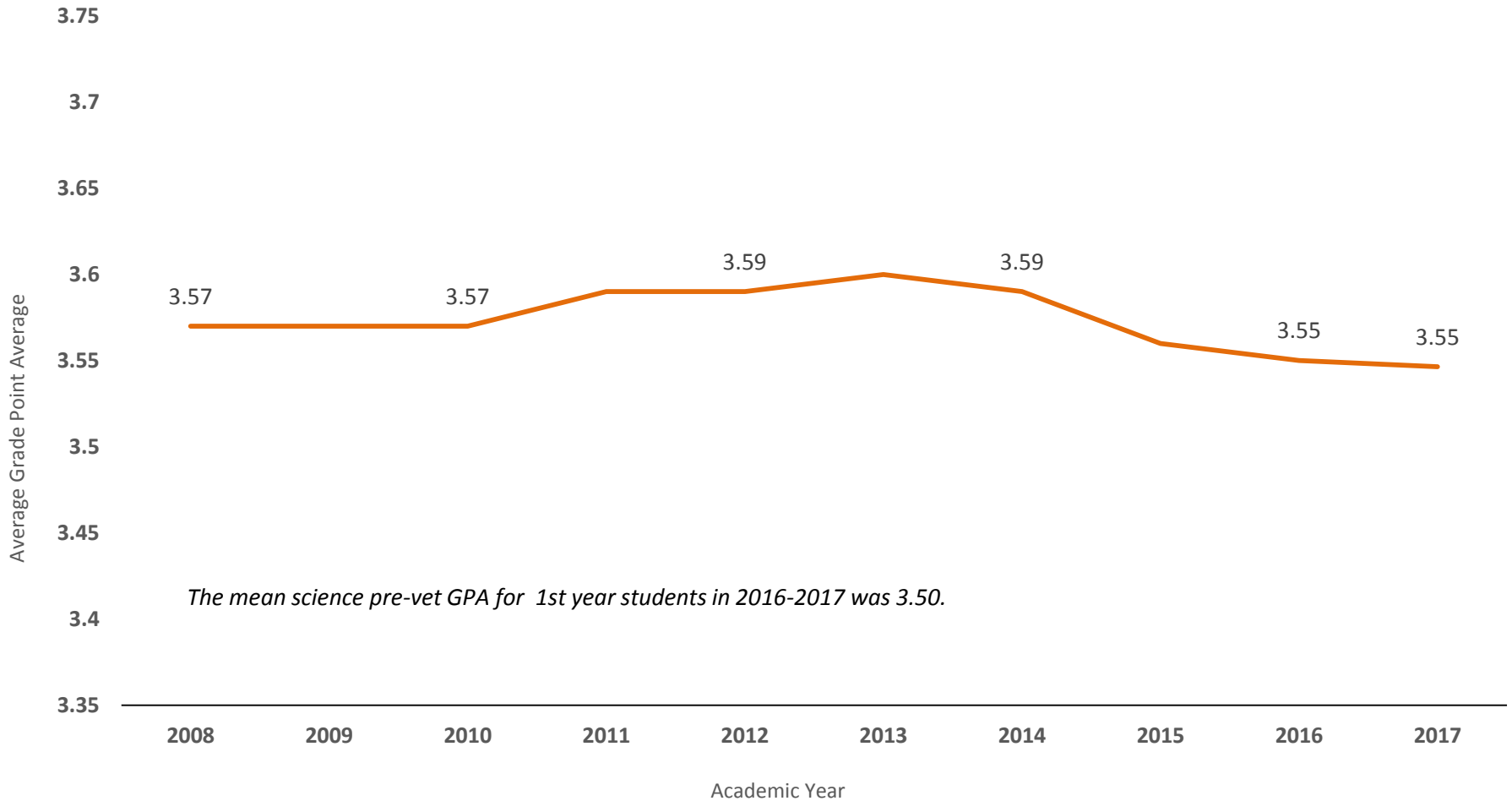

Line chart is shown on an excerpted scale of 3.35 to 3.75.

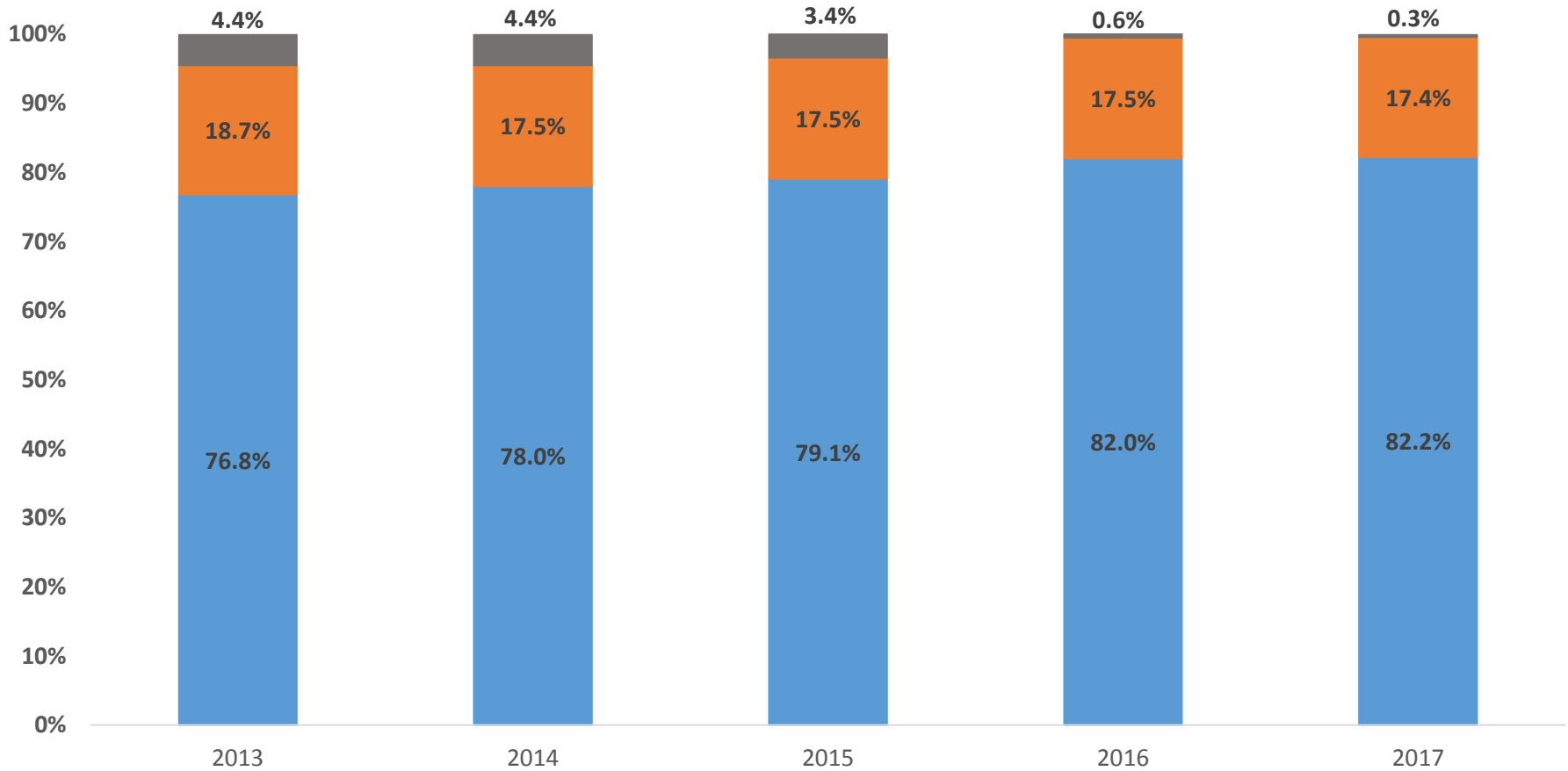


VMCAS Applicants by Gender

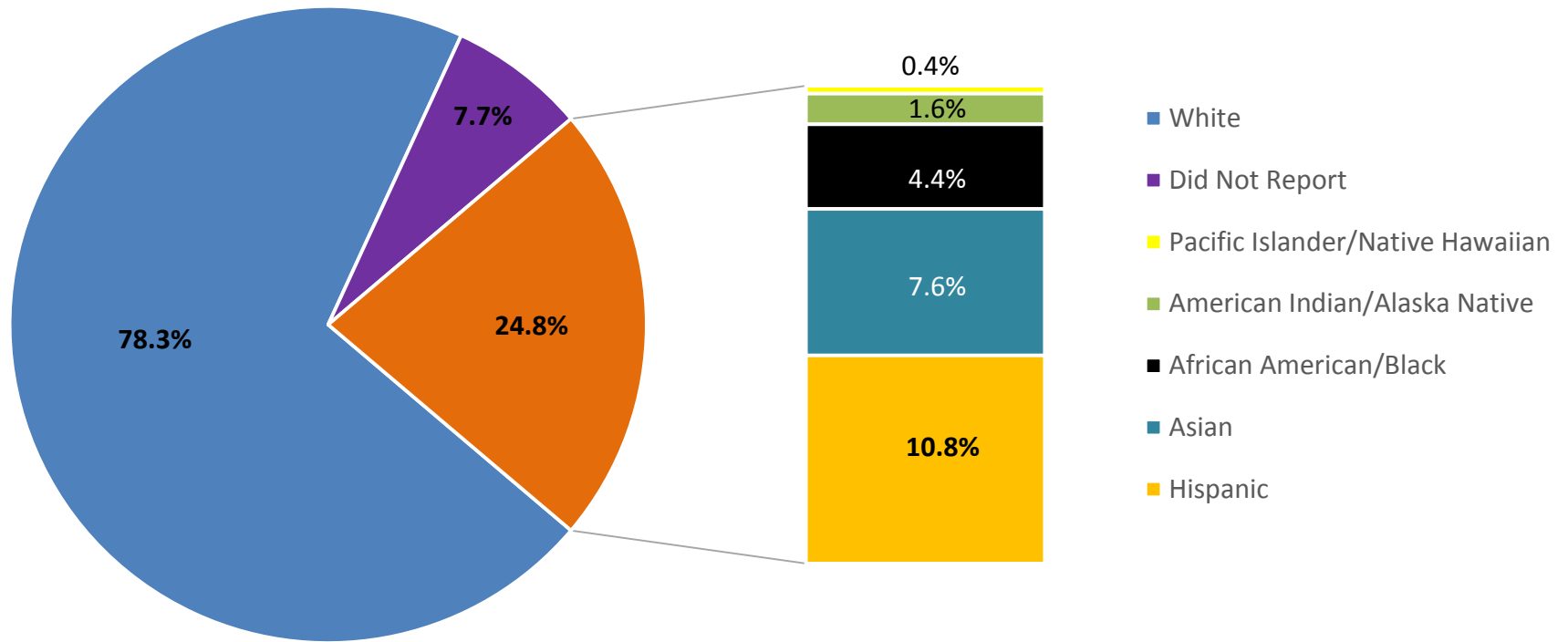

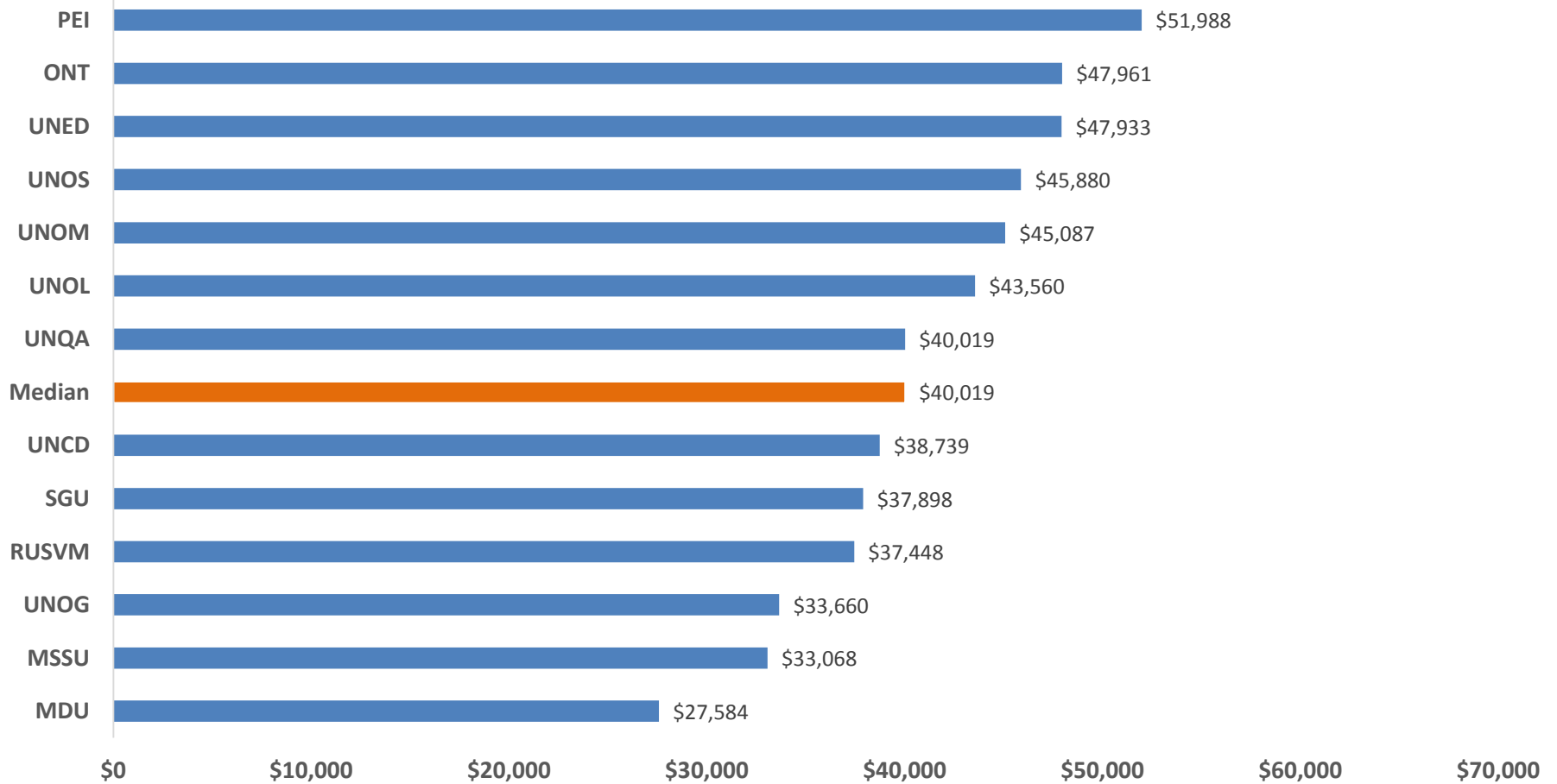

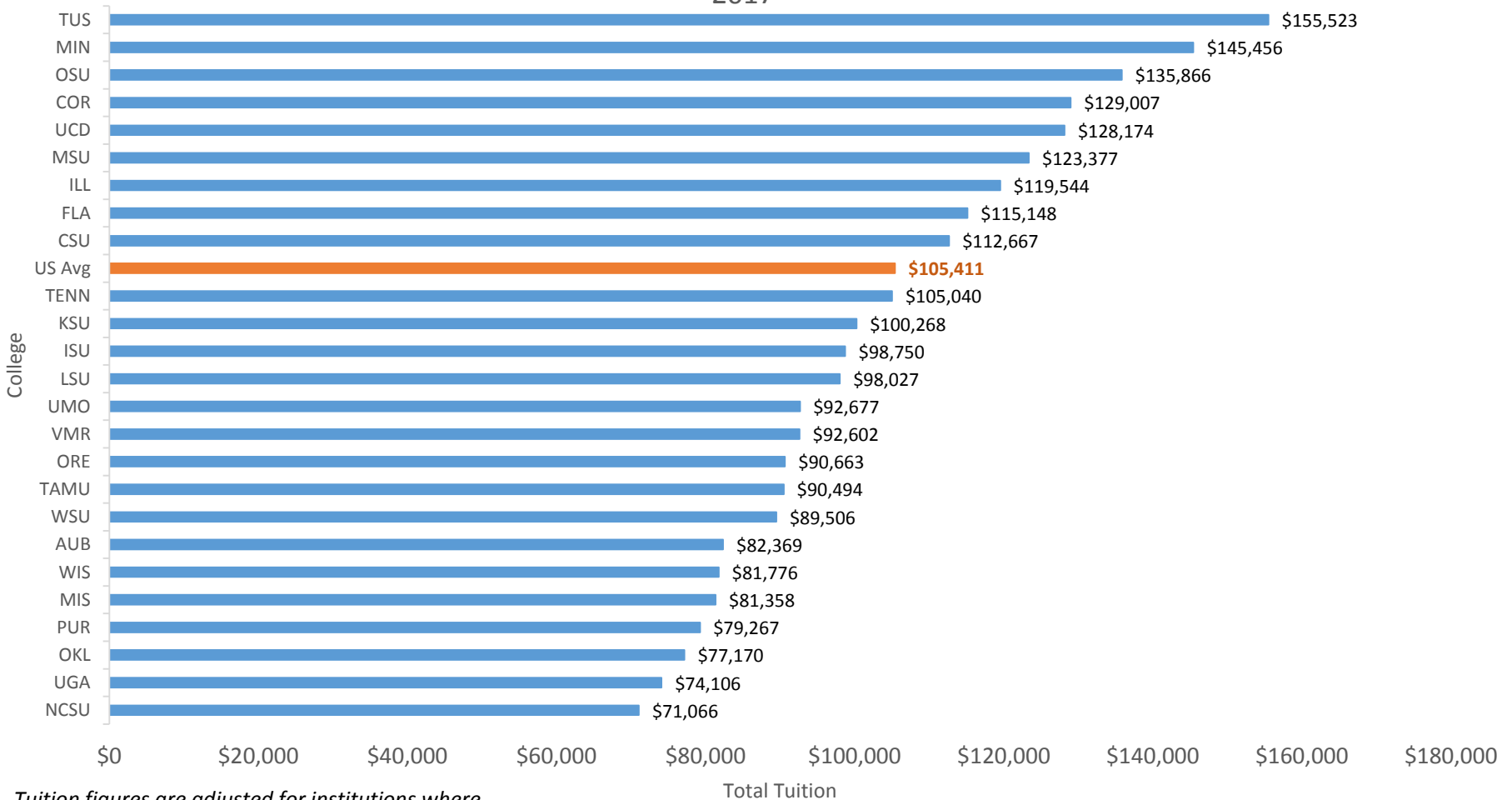


Total Subsidized Tuition for Class of 2016

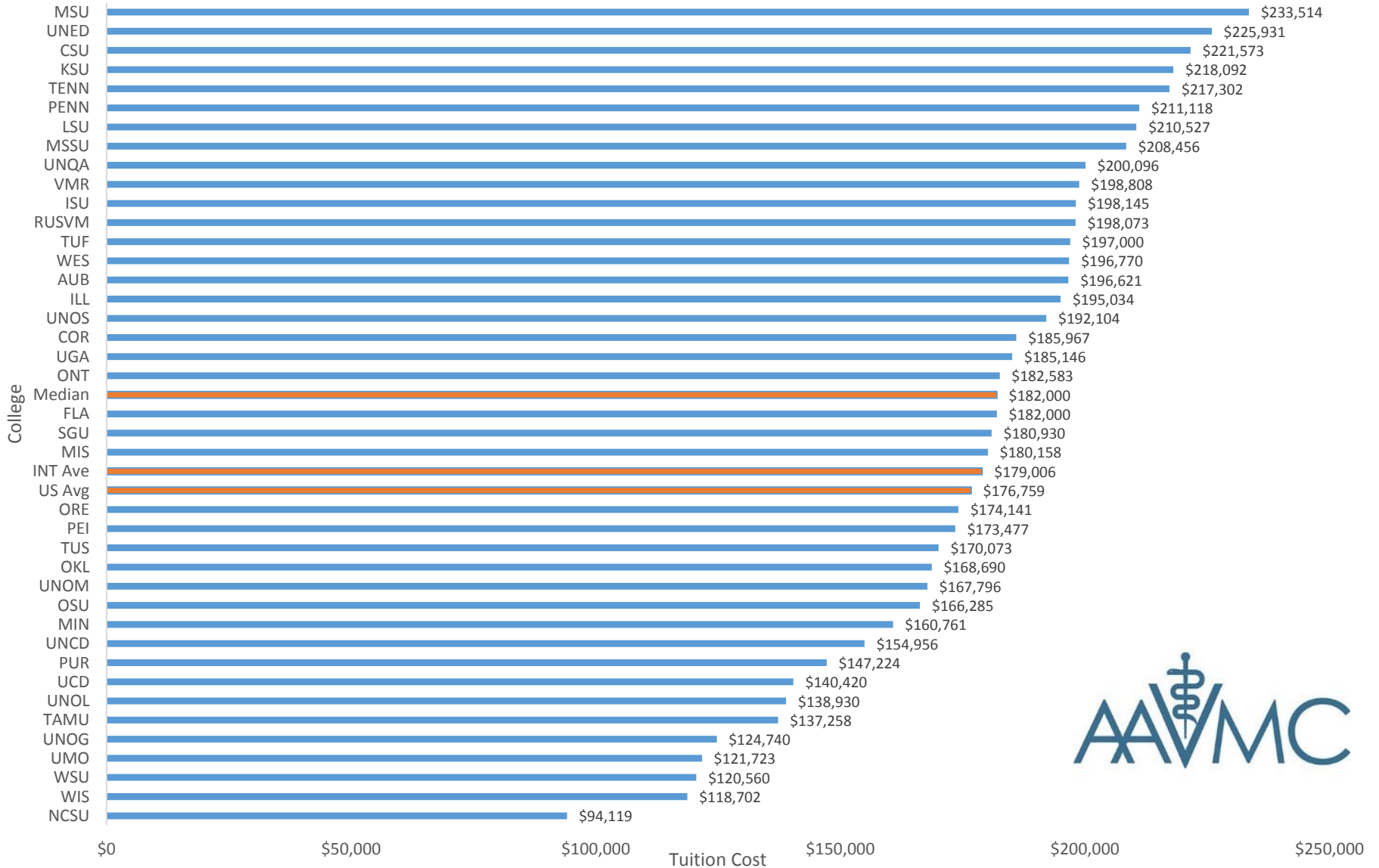

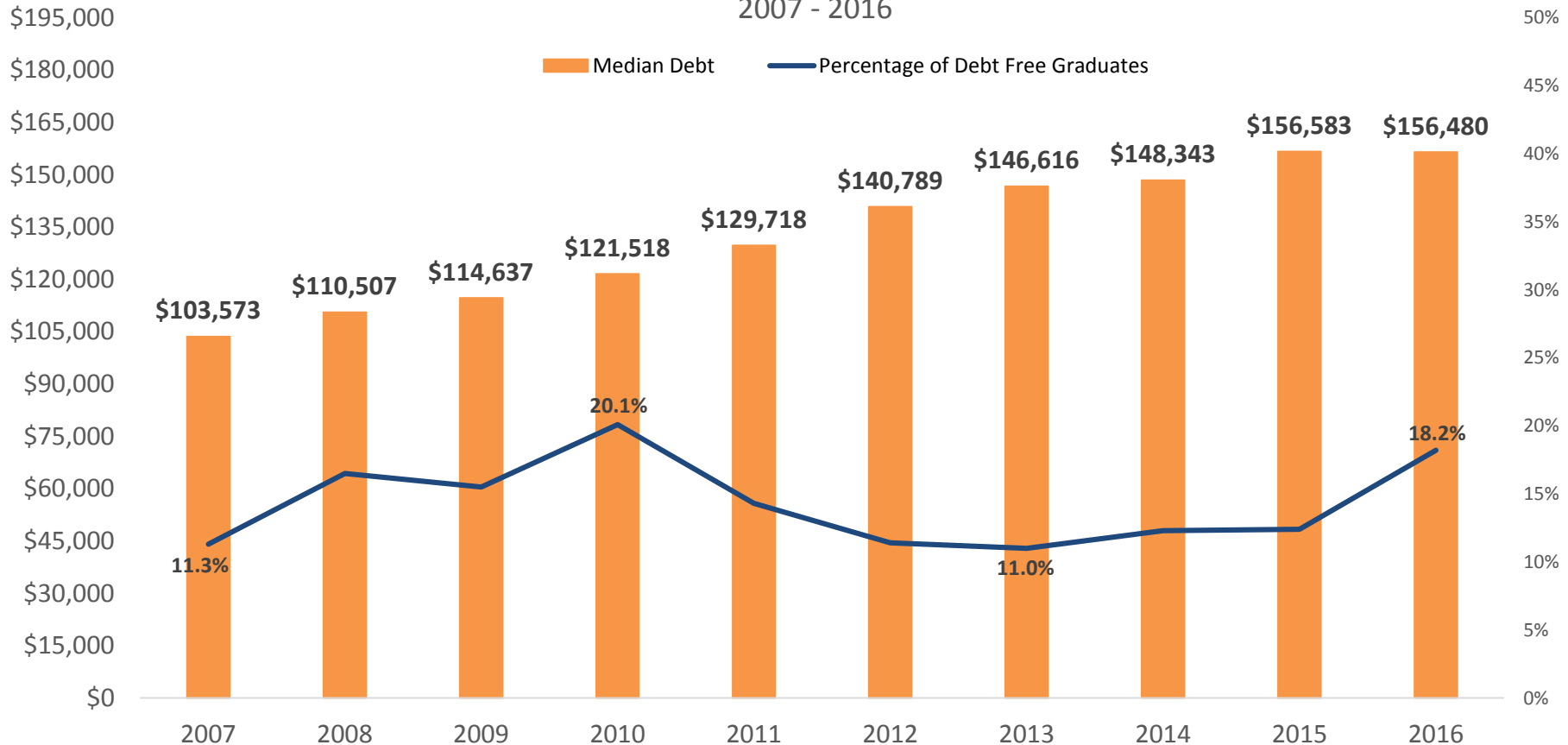
Total Unsubsidized Tuition for Class of 2016

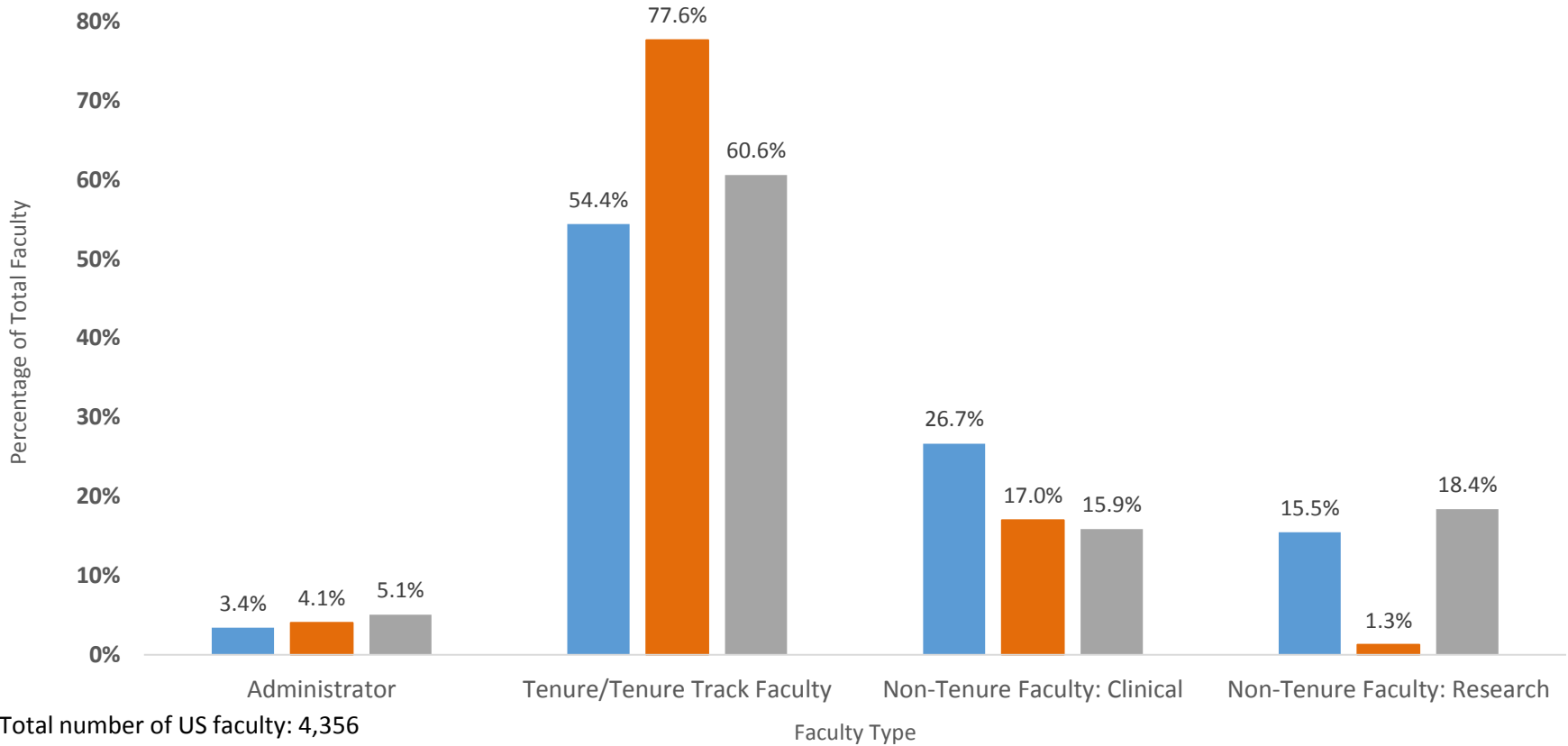

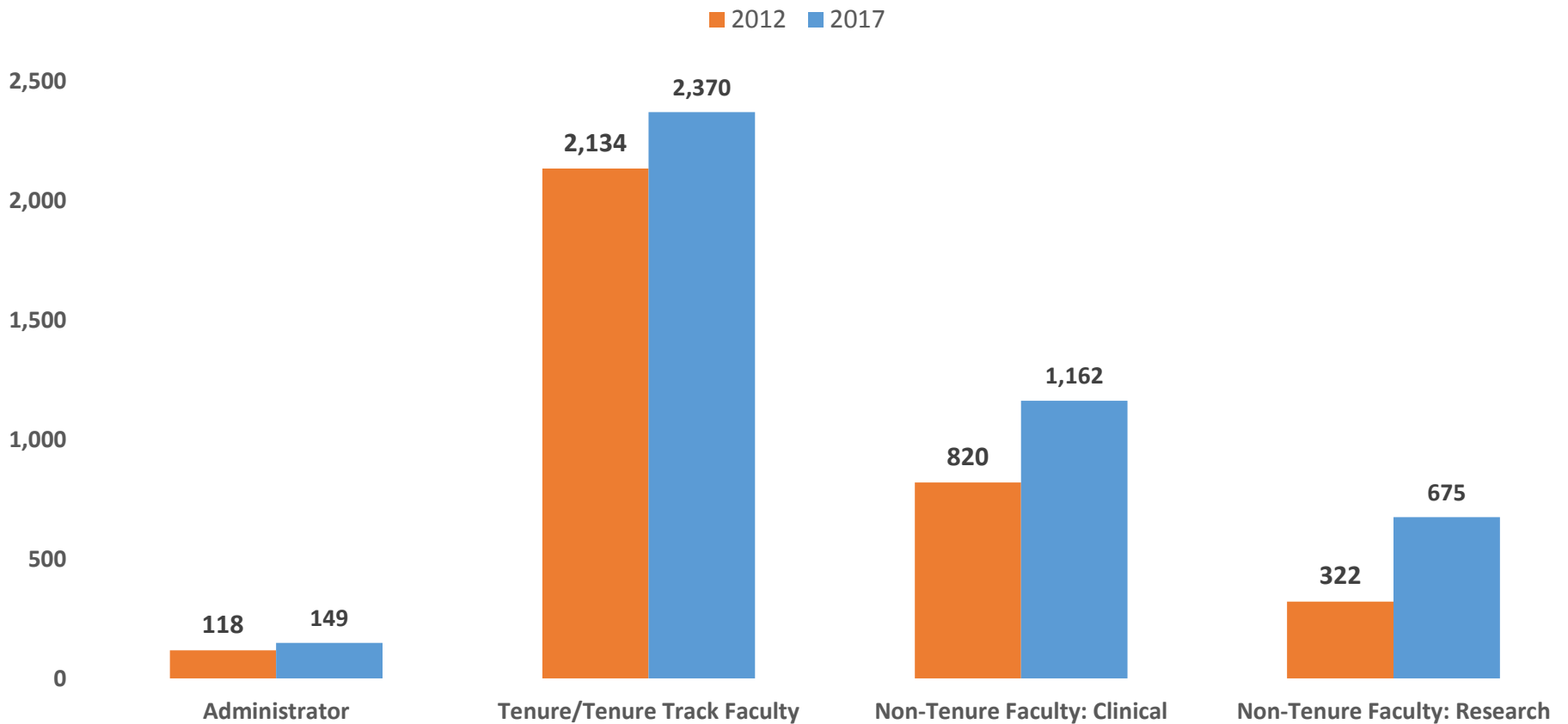

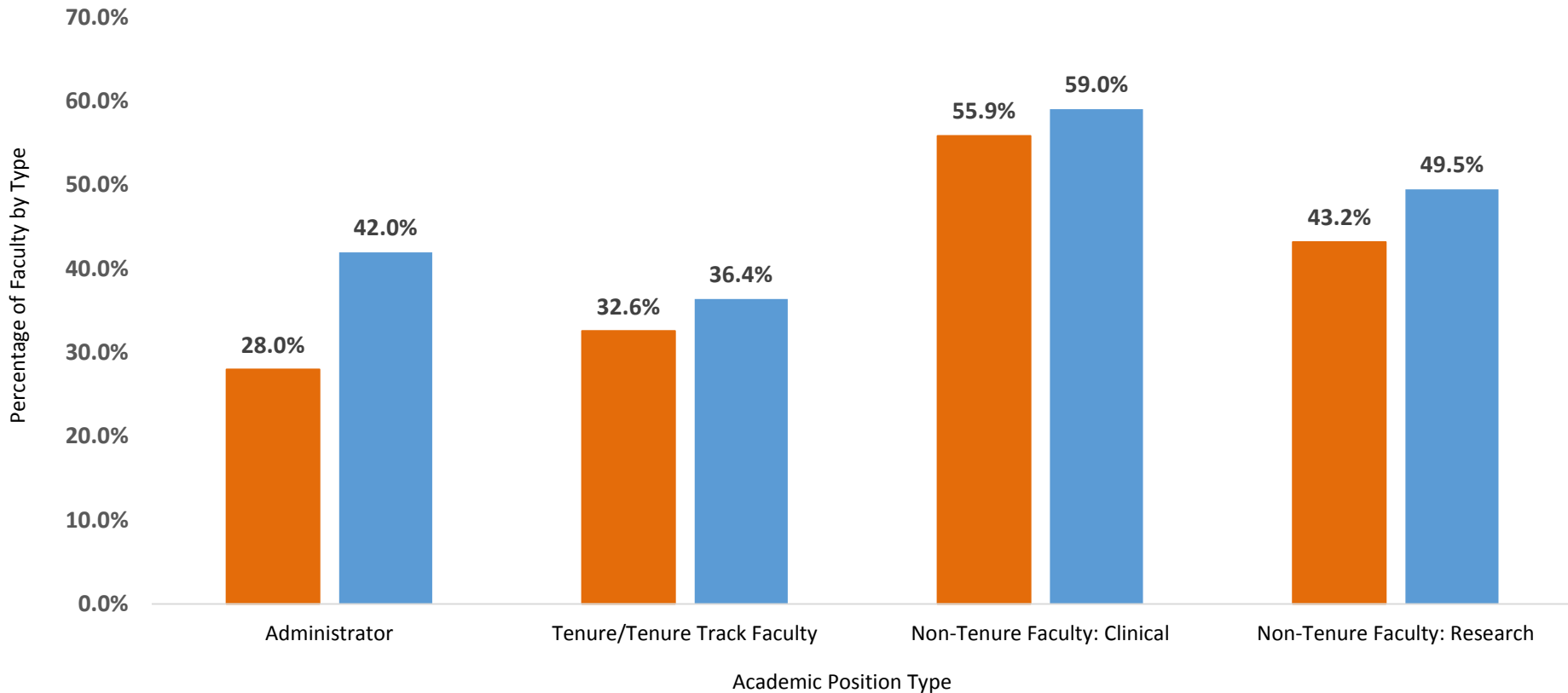

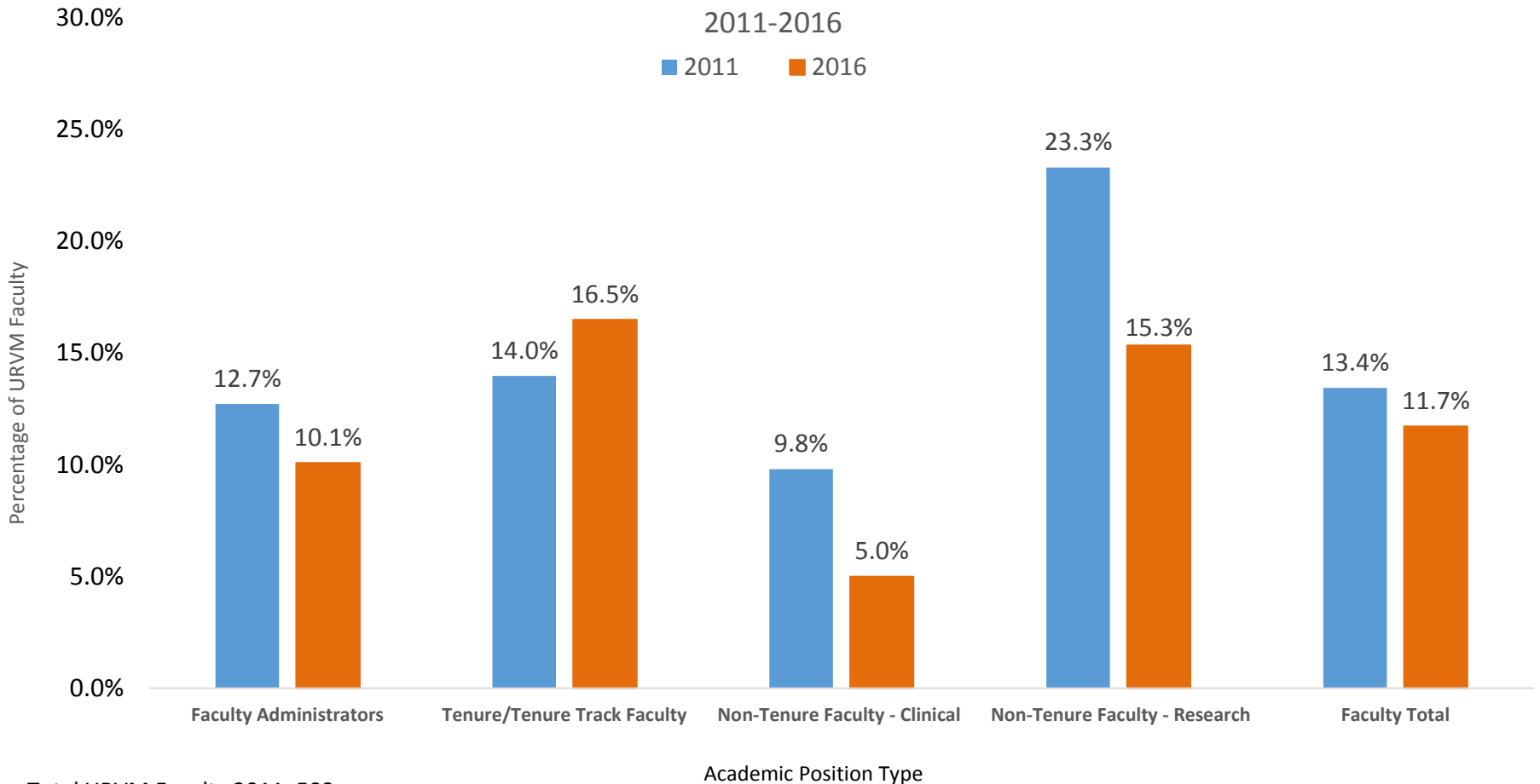

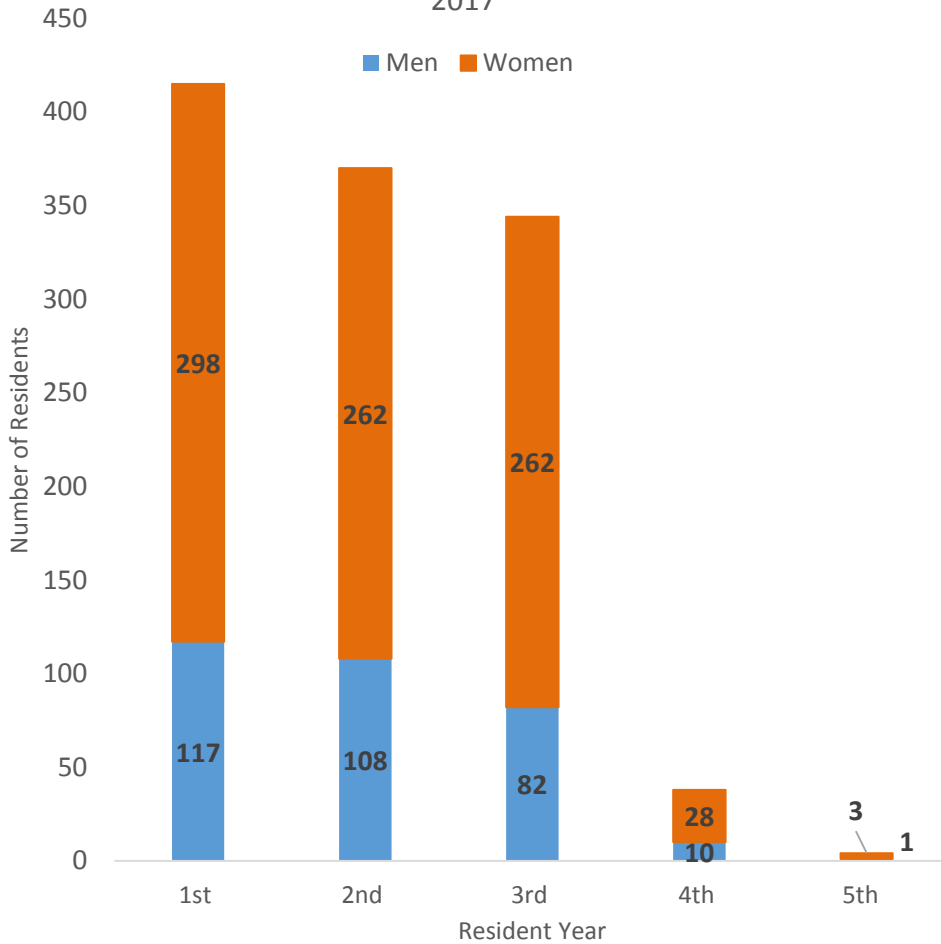

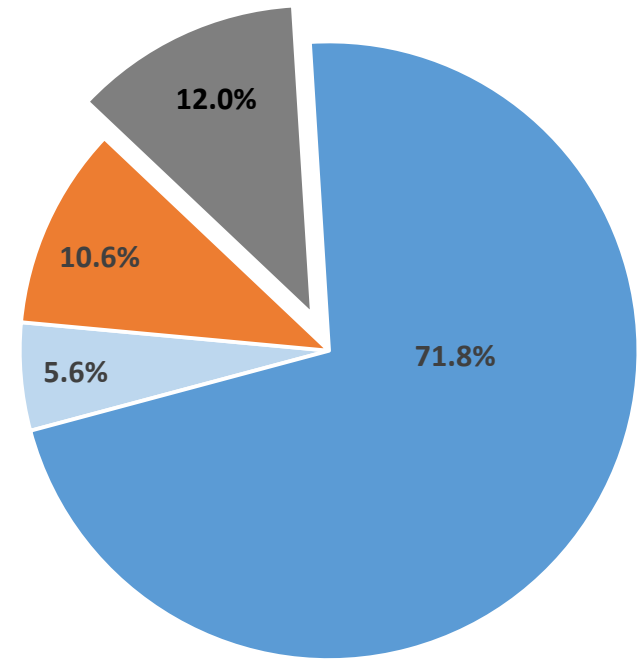

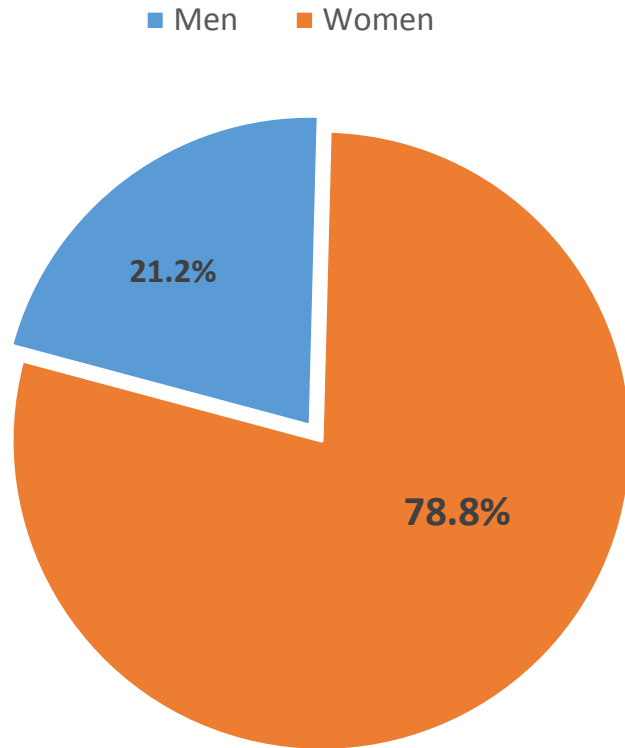

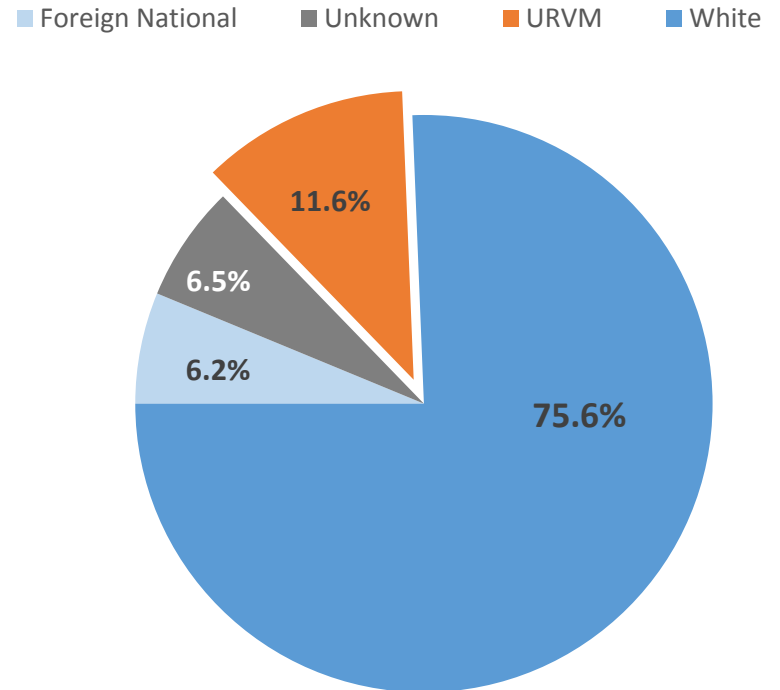




Interns by Gender at US Colleges of Veterinary Medicine

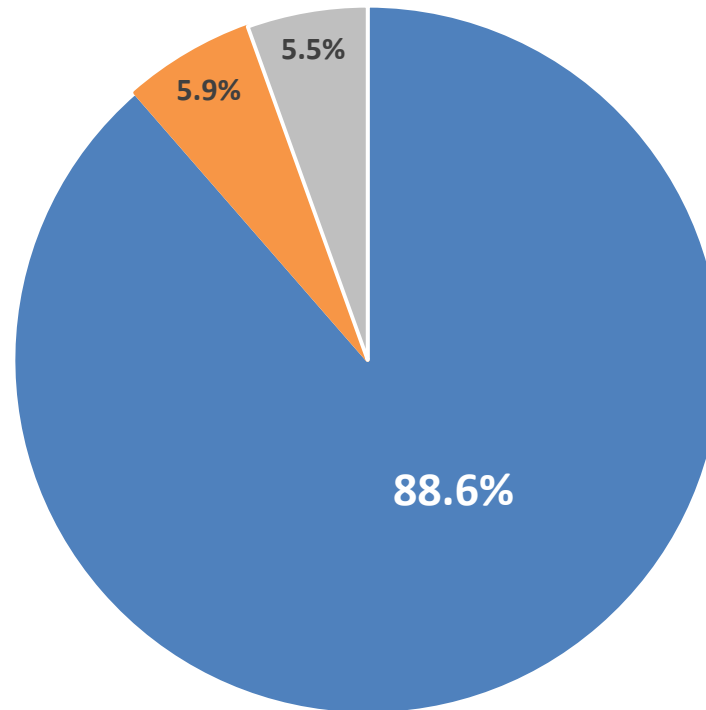
