Upon Acceptance, Obtain Proper Visa

- Accepting Institution Provides International Student With Confirmation of Acceptance and Documents Required to Obtain the Proper Visa



Objective: International Veterinary Scholar, With DVM or Equivalent Degree and/or Advanced Degrees, Seeks Research Experience



- Identify Institution/Investigator of Choice (Same Process as Defined For International Scholar, Above)
 - Opportunities
 - Postdoctoral Fellow
 - Visiting Scientist
 - Research Area or Subject (Same Process as Defined For International Scholar, Above)

Contact The Desired Investigator or Institution



- Identify Source of Financial Support
 - Investigator May Have Funding
 - Fellow or Visiting Scientist May Have Funding
 - Determine Length of Time

Final Arrangements: Fellow or Visiting Scholar



- Visiting Scholar or Fellow Writes Investigator Summary of Agreed Upon Arrangements
 - Host Investigator Prepares Letter of Support to His/Her Institutional Office of International Affairs
 - Office of International Affairs Provides Fellow or Visiting Scientist With Documents Necessary to Acquire Proper Visa
