Association of American Veterinary Medical Colleges (AAVMC)

The Association of American Veterinary Medical Colleges (AAVMC) coordinates the national and international affairs of all veterinary medical colleges in the United States and Canada, 9 departments of veterinary science, 7 departments of comparative medicine, 3 other veterinary medical education institutions, and 7 international colleges of veterinary medicine.
