The **Research** group seeks to advance scholarship in veterinary education. Individuals with expertise in one or more of the following areas are encouraged to submit their nomination for the Research group:

- Qualitative research methods and data analysis
- Quantitative research methods and data analysis
- Big data analytics
- Expertise in needs assessment
- Translation of evidence-based medicine into first-opinion practice

The **Educator & Curricular Development** (ECD) group will provide resources to enhance veterinary education. Individuals with expertise in one or more of the following areas are encouraged to submit their nomination for the ECD group:

- Outcomes-based education and curriculum design
- Training educators in educational principles and practices as well as effective curriculum design
- Developing online learning materials

The **Advocacy** group will educate stakeholders using evidence to promote and disseminate best practices in veterinary education. Individuals with expertise in one or more of the following areas are encouraged to submit their nomination for the Advocacy group:

- Identifying, engaging, and educating stakeholders
- Creating advocacy materials and identifying events for dissemination
- Identifying and disseminating evidence of best practices

**These groups are expected to work closely together and strong teamwork skills are considered essential. Other desirable qualities include:**

- Enthusiasm
- Sense of humor
- Patience
- Persistence
- Ability to share, listen and discuss perspectives to reach consensus
- Willingness to travel (COVID-dependent)
