- The membership of the Association of American Veterinary Medical Colleges is pleased to present the AAVMC Annual Data Report 2016-2017. This report includes data concerning veterinary school faculty, students and applicants and represents the most frequently requested data from the AAVMC.
- This report includes, but is not limited to, a collection of data compiled through an internal members-only survey conducted each fall. The 30 colleges and schools of veterinary medicine in the United States, 5 Canadian colleges, and 14 international institutions were surveyed. A final report is distributed exclusively to participating members of the AAVMC in December. The Annual Data Report features data on faculty, staff, residents, interns and students from the all participating members of the AAVMC.



Total DVM Student Enrollment at US Colleges of Veterinary Medicine







Number of Seats in the First Year Class By US College of Veterinary Medicine AAVMC Internal Reports 2016-2017








#### Number of Seats in the First Year Class
















VMCAS Applicants by Gender





First Year Subsidized Tuition at the US Colleges of Veterinary Medicine Maximums, Minimum & Medians





















Interns by URVM Status at US Colleges of Veterinary Medicine AAVMC Internal Data Reports 2017
