Dr. Michael Grguric graduated from The Ohio State University Veterinary College and grew up in the Cleveland area. He has a master's degree in physiology and has been published four times in graduate school and once in veterinary school. The publication in veterinary school was for using ultrasound to guide cervical joint injections in equines. He further grew Ohio Pet Vet to 13 hospitals with 32 doctors and over 130 employees that covered three states. He eventually transitioned out of his ownership.

Dr. Grguric has always worked closely with the veterinary school at The Ohio State University by providing mentorship to students and new graduates, working with admissions, and teaching or lecturing at times at the college. He has been involved with the OVMA in helping develop mentor programs and with the AzVMA. He is very excited to be practicing veterinary medicine in his surrounding community again. He has recently started to rebuild hospitals in the surrounding areas where he hopes to again provide the community with quality veterinary care that focuses on spectrum of care and treating each pet as if it were his own. He firmly believes in the hospital relationship with the surrounding communities. Some of the areas of veterinary medicine that he enjoys are performing ultrasounds, emergency medicine, orthopedics, and interacting with the clients. Dr. Grguric loves spending time with the clients by talking and getting to know more about them, their families, and their pets. Being involved and giving back to the community is very important to Dr. Grguric. One thing that he does is coach both basketball and football at a local high school. Dr. Grguric and his wife, Laura, are involved in many other ways with the surrounding communities.
