



Dr. Kristin Jankowski, VMD, CCRP is a consultant regarding issues of Access to Care, Spectrum of Care, and One Health Clinics. She has extensive experience in private general practice, speciality rehabilitation, and teaching primary care in an academic environment. From 2020-2023 she served as an Assistant Clinical Professor of Small Animal Primary Care and as the Access to Care Service Chief at UC Davis Veterinary Medical Teaching Hospital.
