VMCAS Application Fees

Your VMCAS fee covers the following services

- 1. The processing and transmission of your VMCAS Electronic Application
- 2. The processing and transmission of your Letters of Recommendation
- 3. Application verification
- 4. VMCAS Student and Advisor support

NOTE: VMCAS does not provide refunds under any circumstances, including when an applicant accidentally chooses the wrong school.

Fees

VMCAS charges \$241 for the first program you apply to and \$132 for each additional program. Application fees are calculated based on the number of colleges to which you are applying.

Fee Assistance Program:

A limited number of VMCAS fee waivers are provided to qualified applicants on a first-come, first-served basis until allotted funds are exhausted. Each waiver covers only the initial application fee, so if you wish to apply to additional programs, you are responsible for the remaining balance. If you receive a fee waiver (fee reimbursement) during a previous cycle, you may still apply for fee assistance in the next cycle. The VMCAS fee assistance program will open in June. Supplemental Applications and Fees

Some VMCAS institutions require a supplemental application and/or fee, which should be paid directly to the institution—not to VMCAS. Check each college's *requirement s*) entry for supplemental fee and/or application requirements and deadlines.

Note: Submitting a supplemental application or fee does not necessarily mean your VMCAS application is complete. Each college may have additional requirements. **Refer to the** <u>Veterinary Medicine Admission Requirements</u> directory and VMCAS application instructions for full details.
